Local artist, Katrina Elliott, has engaged with staff, patients, family and friends at the Gladstone Base Cancer Care Unit to help fold 1000 paper cranes as part of **One Wish**, an exhibition exploring hope, health, courage and support. Inspired by the traditional belief of Senbazuru - if one folds 1000 cranes, one's wish will come true - the locally handmade cranes will form part of a large installation displayed within the exhibition. Photography, sculpture and assemblage works will also be on display along with a hands-on station that gives visitors the opportunity to participate in Senbazuru.
