Gladstone Region Regional Arts Development Fund

What is the Fund?

- Regional Arts Development Fund is a partnership program between Arts Queensland and the Gladstone Regional Council.
- Around \$50,000 is provided annually for arts and cultural activities that support arts and cultural development in the community. It also assists with professional development for artists and arts workers.
- Decisions about funding are made by a volunteer committee of Gladstone Region's arts, cultural and education workers who understand the needs and aspirations of the community. This grass roots approach has made the program one of the most successful funding operations in Australia.

Committee Role

The Regional Arts Development Fund committee has 6 key annual responsibilities

- Attending and participating in meetings (usually three per year)
- Attending and participating in cheque presentations to successful applicants
- Assessing applications and outcome reports - twice yearly
- Joining in the bidding and reporting cycles
- Promoting the Regional Arts Development Fund program
- Committee members stand for election at each annual general meeting
